Doctor Chitrit received his title of Medical Surgeon from the La Salle University, A. C. in Mexico D.F. in 1983. In 2004, attended the World course of Laparoscopic Surgery, the international course of Bariatric Laparoscopic Surgery and the international course in Colon Laparoscopic Surgery. In the same year, attended the Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery course at the Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts.
